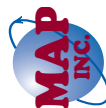

## 6. Planned giving

Other financial tools allow you to establish your legacy now. A **Charitable Remainder Trust** lets you use your assets and receive income from them while living, with the money ultimately going to your beneficiaries and the principle to a charity. With **Charitable Lead Trusts**, a non-profit like DrugSense receives your property or investment income while you are still alive, but the principle goes to your beneficiaries on your passing. Both tools offer tax advantages to you and your heirs.

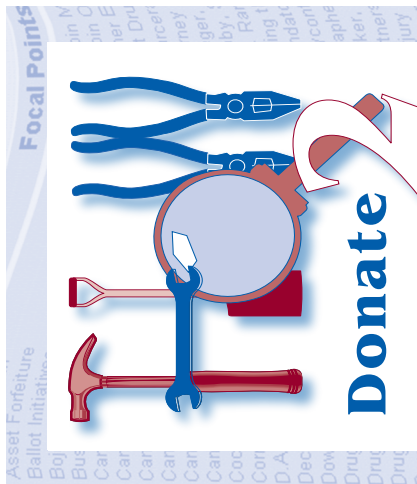
